How Many 18-29 year olds leave Evangelical Churches?

712 will quit the faith today, another 712 tomorrow, and so forth. That's 2.6 million who will leave the faith at some point between 18th and 29th birthdays.

Quote: "The percentage of evangelicals decreases with each younger generation, while the percentage of agnostics and atheists increases in younger generations. The net effect over time will be a tsunami-like culture shift, as the older generations pass away. The Pew's age-by-religion findings reveal that the evangelical church is top-heavy that is, 45% of evangelicals will die with the next 29 years – meaning that evangelicals in the population could drop from about 7% of Americans now to about 4% or less – unless new disciples generated."



Quote: "Evangelical Christianity is dying. The great evangelical movements of today are not vanguard. They are a remnant unraveling at every edge. Look at it any way you like: Conversions. Baptisms. Membership. Participation. Giving. Attendance. Religious Literacy. Effect on culture. All are down and dropping. It's no secret."

Globally there are 19 million conversions annually and 19 million defections from Christianity.



WEEKLY CHURCH ATTENDANCE: 1993-2020







n = 96,171 U.S. adults | 2000-2020



The Theology of the Gospel of John

- Jesus replaced all the institutions of the Jewish faith with Himself!
- For about 100-200 years after the Ascension, it was all house churches – exclusively! But... we went back to the old methodologies.



The Early Church

- There were no church "buildings" in the New Testament nor in the Early Church
- The church was the people, assembled believers, they gathered in homes.
- In many cities, a network of house churches



If the method isn't working...

- My personal struggle for fulfillment
- The new wine is only for new wineskins
- We taste the old wine and say, "Ach! It's good enough."


